Dear Prospective LCB Member,

We are currently planning and scheduling personnel for our 2021 concert season. Our proposed schedule runs from Wednesday, May 26, through Labor Day, September 6. Concerts will start at 7:30, except for July 4 (8:00 pm) and Labor Day (7:00 pm). Safety of our musicians and audience member is of utmost importance and we will make every effort to reduce the risk for everyone. Toward that end, **we strongly urge all musicians to get fully vaccinated** before your first scheduled rehearsal if possible. We realize high school students might only be able to get their first vaccine by the beginning of our season, but that is 80% better than no vaccine. We hope to secure rehearsal space that will allow us to spread out so we can properly distance ourselves. The specific location has yet to be determined, but we do know it will **not** be at **Purdue**. We may have to rehearse outdoors at Riehle Plaza. We are still ironing out all the details and will keep you informed.

Failure to come to a scheduled rehearsal with no notice could result in losing future opportunities to play with the band. The Player Information page is to be sent directly back to your section leader. If you feel uncomfortable replying to this by email, you may print out the first two pages and simply mail them to your section leader. Addresses are included on the "Section Leaders 2021" page.*

Your section leader will contact you with your concert assignments. Your name and available dates will be kept on file as part of our substitute list if you are not needed for every concert that you requested. Please be aware that we have many returning members as well as new members wanting to play, so your section leader may not be able to use you for all of your available times.

## **2021 General Information (also available on our website)**

### **SECTION LEADERS**

Section leaders will notify everyone of assigned concerts. Again, some of the band's sections have many interested players, so it is difficult to use all of everyone's available dates. Please contact your section leader IMMEDIATELY if you cannot make an assigned rehearsal or concert. (See next page for section leader names and addresses. Keep it for further reference.)

### **PAY SCALE**

\$10 per rehearsal for everyone

\$10 per concert for nonunion members; \$40 per concert for *paid-up* union members

(Some differences apply to July 4th sequence.)

### **MILEAGE**

Players outside of Tippecanoe County receive 25 cents per mile for rehearsals and concerts. Mileage is based on a standard mileage chart from Lafayette to your city.

### **PAYROLL**

Paychecks will be mailed twice during the season, around 7/15/21 and 9/15/21.

### **SEATING**

LCB section leaders seat strong players in each part of a section, e.g., the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> clarinets will each have leadership players assigned to them. We wish to have a strong, well-balanced concert band sound.

### **CONCERT DRESS**

Players wear red polo shirts with the LCB logo, with black slacks or skirts, and black socks and shoes. To order a shirt, see the Player Information Sheet.

### **UNION**

To join the musicians' union (Indianapolis Musicians, Local #3 of the AF of M), call the union office at 317-636-3595.

### **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**
